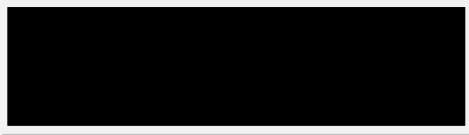
Patients report:

He was with his combatants on a road near by Ras Al-Ain (exactly location unknown). Their convoy got hit by an airstrike, he and his combatants where about 15-20m away from the explosion.

The patient just remembers the noise of a rocket and the smell of Sulfur.

He was brought to Tal Tamr Hospital and then referred to National Hospital Hassakeh. The clothes got changed and remained in Hassakeh hospital. In the 15th of October he arrived to KRG (IRAQ)
